

# Commodity Supplemental Food Program

The Wichita and Affiliated Tribes will be taking applications for the Commodity Food Supplemental Food Program (CSFP). Applicants must live in Caddo County and be at least 60 years of age or older and provide the following:

- Complete a certified application for CSFP
- Provide Date of Birth
- Provide Household Income (Self-Declared)
- Sign and Date Application
- Provide Name of Proxy if you would like for someone to pick up your food package for you.



The Wichita and Affiliated Tribes have been approved to provide 200 food boxes to qualified individuals 60 years and older. If you are not one of the first 200 certified participants, you will be placed on a waiting list. If anyone does not pick up their food package, we will contact the next name on the list. If a participant misses 3 consecutive months, their name will be removed from the list and replaced with the next certified participant.

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Persons with disabilities who require alternative means of communication for program information (e.g. Braille, large print, audiotope, American Sign Language, etc.), should contact the Agency (State or local) where they applied for benefits. Additionally, program information may be made available in languages other than English.
