Kiowa Tribe Resolution Number KL-CY-2025-00X

Resolution to adopt the K.E.A. Mission Statement, Affirming the Role of Education in Personal Growth and Strengthened Kiowa Identity.

Whereas, the Kiowa Education Agency, established August 13th, 2022, has become a fundamental agency for personal growth and self-discovery, enabling individuals to reach their full potential, and contribute meaningfully to family and community;

Whereas, the Kiowa people have a rich cultural heritage that is integral to our identity, and preserving this heritage is essential for the continuation of our traditions, language, and ways of life;

Whereas, there is any concern that the pursuit of education may be misconstrued as a departure from our cultural roots or as an adoption of colonial or Western values, we affirm the role of education in concert with personal growth and Kiowa identity;

Be it resolved, that education, as pursued by the Kiowa people, is a means to strengthen and enhance our identity, equipping us to preserve and promote our language, culture, and traditions in a rapidly changing world;

Be it further resolved, that the sector of our tribal organization that is solely dedicated to the personal growth, learning, and development of the Kiowa people is the Kiowa Education Agency;

Be it further resolved, that the Kiowa Education Agency reaffirms its commitment to integrating Kiowa cultural values, language, and teachings into educational efforts, ensuring that learning is a complimentary path to both personal development and cultural preservation;

Be it further resolved, that all programmatic functions of the Kiowa Education Agency seek to fulfill the charge and obligation to create spaces for the inclusion of Kiowa cultural values, language, history, art, culture, teachings and contemporary life as a Kiowa-centered and holistic approach;

Be it further resolved, that the pursuit of education by Kiowa individuals does not represent an abandonment of our heritage or a succumbing to colonialism but is instead an act of empowerment, allowing us to navigate diverse spaces while remaining grounded in our Kiowa identity;

Be it further resolved, this resolution serves as a declaration that the Kiowa Education Agency views education as a vital component of cultural reclamation and sustainability, language continuance, resilience, and continuous evolution of our people.

Through Kiowa-centered and holistic approaches we embrace education an act of empowerment, allowing us to navigate diverse spaces while remaining grounded in our Kiowa identity. For all operations and decisions, education is declared as a vital component of cultural reclamation and sustainability, language continuance, resilience, and the continuous evolution of our Kiowa people.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby adopts the *K.E.A. Mission Statement, Affirming the Role of Education in Personal Growth and Strengthened Kiowa Identity*.
