THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EQUITY IN SOCIAL MEDIA ACCESS BY GOVERNMENT BRANCHES ACT OF 2025

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation and has been so since time immemorial; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe exercises full enjoyment of the inherent powers of government, including self-determination and autonomy over internal affairs encompassing Tribe citizens, lands, and resources; and,

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2017, qualified voters of the Tribe ratified the Kiowa Constitution as "the supreme law of the land"; and,

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Legislature is vested with the agency to pass laws and resolutions pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of same Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2025, the Legislature passed The Equity in Social Media Access by Government Branches Act of 2025, which was signed into law by Chairman Spottedbird six days later; and,

WHEREAS, repeated violations of same law have occurred since October 29, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature has identified the imperative to clarify provisions of the statutory infrastructure governing regulatory actions taken by the Executive Branch of the Tribe that suppress transparent online discourse among Tribe citizens;

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the Legislature hereby adopts THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EQUITY IN SOCIAL MEDIA ACCESS BY GOVERNMENT BRANCHES ACT OF 2025.
