2025 MORATORIUM ON NEW TRIBALLY OWNED CORPORATIONS

At a duly called Legislative Regular Session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held this day of, 2025, the following resolution, was adopted.
WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation and has been so since time immemorial; and,
WHEREAS, the Tribe exercises full enjoyment of the inherent powers of government, including self-determination and autonomy over internal affairs encompassing Tribe citizens, lands, and resources; and,
WHEREAS, on April 17, 2017, qualified voters of the Tribe ratified the Kiowa Constitution as "the supreme law of the land"; and,
WHEREAS , the Kiowa Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of same Constitution; and,
WHEREAS, the Legislature is empowered by same Constitution to promulgate codes and statutes to protect Kiowa Tribal Citizens; and,
WHEREAS, the Legislature has concerns about the possible abuse and mismanagement of Tribally Owned Corporations created pursuant to Art. 5 of the Kiowa Tribe Uniform Commercial Business Code of 2023, Resolution No. KL-CY-2023-011;
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Kiowa Tribe Legislature, having been delegated certain authorities under the Kiowa Constitution, the governing body of the Kiowa Tribe, and in an effort to safeguard the assets of the Kiowa Tribe, does hereby establish a moratorium on the issuance of new Articles of Incorporation for the creation of new Tribally-Owned Corporations pursuant to Article 5, Section 8(a) of the Kiowa Tribe Uniform Commercial Business Code of 2023, Resolution No. KL-CY-2023-011. This moratorium shall continue from the effective date of this resolution until duly repealed by the Legislature.
