WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe is a federally recognized sovereign Indian tribe headquartered in Carnegie, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Legislative Branch is the duly authorized and elected legislative body of the Kiowa Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Boys and Girls Club of the Kiowa Tribe will be created as initiated by the Kiowa Education Agency (K.E.A.) to provide a safe place to implement culturally-relevant and outcome-driven programs while strengthening and empowering the wellness and cultural identity of our Native Youth through programming that promotes positive youth development and growth in spiritual, cultural, social, emotional, intellectual, and physical dimensions; and

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe recognizes that The Boys & Girls Club of the Kiowa Tribe will provide a valuable service to the community guiding native youth on their path to great futures—support in school, fostering community leadership, promoting sober and healthy lifestyles, increasing workforce preparedness, and engagement in cultural, educational, physical, and social activity as a means to address complex social problems that challenge our youth; and

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Education Agency (K.E.A.) is advancing an unprecedented opportunity to help native youth to lead sustainable change, while embracing their culture and traditions; and

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe is committed to developing the capacity of The Boys & Girls Club of the Kiowa Tribe to consistently and thoughtfully serve native youth through the developed plan to charter our own Boys & Girls Club to maximize our impact; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT approval is hereby granted by the Legislative Branch of the Kiowa Tribe for the creation and support of *The Boys & Girls Club of the Kiowa Tribe*, also to be known as the *Kiowa Boys and Girls Club*.
